In accordance with the W.B. Govt. Order bearing No. <u>354-Edn(CS) dated 02.06.2023</u> and Calcutta University Notification Nos. <u>CSR/04/2023 dated 23.06.2023</u> (For Three-Year Multidisciplinary Courses for B.A./B.Sc.), <u>CSR/05/2023 dated 23.06.2023</u> (For Four-Year B.A./B.Sc. Honours or Honours with Research) & <u>CSR/06/2023 dated</u> <u>23.06.2023</u> (For Four-Year B.Com Honours or Honours with Research & Three-Year B.Com. Programme), it is notified for the general information of all concerned that the Admission Process for admission to Semester wise Four-Year B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Honours or Honours with Research / Three-Year B.A./B.Sc. Multidisciplinary Courses / Three-Year B.Com Programme under Curriculum & Credit Framework, 2022 ( CCF, 2022) will commence on 1st July, 2023. Those who seek admission must apply ONLINE through the college website: https://www.dacollege.org between 01.07.2023 (00.01 AM) and 15.07.2023 (11.59 PM). There shall be no scope for submission of Applications through offline mode.

The complete merit-based list of valid applicants and 1st Admission list will be published on the college website on **20th July, 2023 after 06-30 p.m**. The applicants enlisted for admission (1st Admission List, 2nd Admission List, and so on, subject to the availability of seats) will be allowed to pay admission fees online from **21st July, 2023 onwards** [specific date and time of payment of admission fees will be mentioned in the respective admission list(s)].

The valid and eligible candidates shall be enlisted in the Complete Merit List as well as in the Admission Lists (Academic Session 2023- 2024) subject to the fulfillment of the conditions as laid down in the Calcutta University Notification Nos. CSR/04/2023 dated 23.06.2023 (For Three-Year Multidisciplinary Courses for B.A./B.Sc.), CSR/05/2023 dated 23.06.2023 (For Four-Year B.A./B.Sc. Honours or Honours with Research) & CSR/06/2023 dated 23.06.2023 (For Four-Year B.A./B.Sc. Honours or Honours or Honours with Research & Three-Year B.Com Programme). Those who have passed 10+2 examination or its equivalent examination in 2020 and onwards (i.e., in 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023) are eligible to seek admission to **1st Semester** in the above mentioned courses provided that he/she has also passed in English having full marks not less than 100 and fulfill other conditions as mentioned in the above referred CU Notifications.

# Candidates, who have already completed any UG degree earlier, are not eligible to take admission into the above mentioned courses.

# Criteria for application

# For Three-Year B.A./B.Sc. Multidisciplinary Courses / Three-Year B.Com Programme under CCF, 2022.

Passed 10+2 level examination of recognized Board/Council AND also passed in English having full marks not less than 100

# For Four-Year B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Honours or Honours with Research under CCF, 2022.

2.1. For candidates belonging to Un-reserved (including EWS) Categories

• Passed in English having full marks not less than 100

#### AND

• Obtained at least 50% marks in aggregate (average marks of best four subjects excluding Environmental Studies/Education if it is compulsory subject) AND at least 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the 10+ 2 level

#### OR

• Obtained at least 55% marks in the subject or related subject

#### OR

 Obtained 50% marks in aggregate (average marks of best four subjects excluding Environmental Studies/Education if it is a compulsory subject) in case the candidate HAS NOT studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examination (10+2level Exam) provided all other criteria are fulfilled

## **2.2.** For candidates belonging to Reserved Categories **\***\*

• Passed in English having full marks not less than 100

#### AND

- Obtained at least 40% marks in aggregate (average marks of best four subjects excluding Environmental Studies/Education if it is a compulsory subject)
- at least 40% marks in the subject or related subject at the 10+ 2 level

N.B. If the subject 'Environmental Science' is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it can be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.
