In accordance with the W.B. Govt. Order bearing No. 554-Edn(CS) dated 21.08.2024 and Calcutta University Notification Nos. CSR/04/2023 dated 23.06.2023 (For Three-Year Multidisciplinary Courses for B.A./B.Sc.), CSR/05/2023 dated 23.06.2023 (For Four-Year B.A./B.Sc. Honours or Honours with Research) & CSR/06/2023 dated 23.06.2023 (For Four-Year B.Com Honours or Honours with Research & Three-Year B.Com. Programme), it is notified for the general information of all concerned that the Admission Process for admission to Semester wise Four-Year B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Honours or Honours with Research / Three-Year B.A./B.Sc. Multidisciplinary Courses / Three-Year B.Com Programme under Curriculum & Credit Framework, 2022 (CCF, 2022) will commence on 11-09-2024 (at 11-30 a.m.). Those who seek admission must apply ONLINE through the college website: https://www.dacollege.org between 11.09.2024 (from 11-30 a.m.) and 17.09.2024 (till 11-30 p.m.). There shall be no scope for submission of Applications through offline mode.

The complete merit-based list of valid applicants and 1st Admission list will be published on the college website on 21st Sept., 2024 after 06-30 p.m. The applicants enlisted for admission will be allowed to pay admission fees online from 23rd Sept., 2024 [specific date and time of payment of admission fees will be mentioned in the respective admission list(s)].

The valid and eligible candidates shall be enlisted in the Complete Merit List as well as in the Admission Lists (Academic Session 2024- 2025) subject to the fulfillment of the conditions as laid down in the Calcutta University Notification Nos. CSR/04/2023 dated 23.06.2023 (For Three-Year Multidisciplinary Courses for B.A./B.Sc.), CSR/05/2023 dated 23.06.2023 (For Four-Year B.A./B.Sc. Honours or Honours with Research/4-Yr Hons with Core Vocational in Sericulture) & CSR/06/2023 dated 23.06.2023 (For Four-Year B.Com Honours or Honours with Research & Three-Year B.Com Programme). Those who have passed 10+2 examination or its equivalent examination in 2021 and onwards (i.e., in 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024) are eligible to seek admission to 1st Semester in the above mentioned courses provided that he/she has also passed in English having full marks not less than 100 and fulfill other conditions as mentioned in the above referred CU Notifications.

Candidates, who have already completed any UG degree earlier, are not eligible to take admission into the above mentioned courses.

Criteria for application

For Three-Year B.A./B.Sc. Multidisciplinary Courses / Three-Year B.Com Programme under CCF, 2022.

Passed 10+2 level examination of recognized Board/Council AND also passed in English having full marks not less than 100

Passed in English having full marks not less than 100

AND

• Obtained at least 50% marks in aggregate (average marks of best four subjects excluding Environmental Studies/Education if it is compulsory subject) AND at least 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the 10+ 2 level

OR

Obtained at least 55% marks in the subject or related subject

OR

 Obtained 50% marks in aggregate (average marks of best four subjects excluding Environmental Studies/Education if it is a compulsory subject) in case the candidate HAS NOT studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examination (10+2level Exam) provided all other criteria are fulfilled

2.2. For candidates belonging to Reserved Categories **

Passed in English having full marks not less than 100

AND
