Sub : Enhancement of 10% Seats in all Subjects of Undergraduate Pass and Honours Courses in General Degree Colleges from Academic Year 2012- 13.

Sir,

With a view to admitting large number of pass out of (10 + 2) Examinations under different Boards to Under-graduate Pass & Honours Courses, the State Government has considered to increase the number of sanctioned seats in all subjects of Under-graduate Pass & Honours Courses in General Degree Colleges by 10% from the academic year 2012-13. This is in addition to 10% increase, which was affected last year.

I am, therefore, directed to request you to issue necessary circular to all General Degree Colleges to enhance 10% of the sanctioned seats in all subjects of Under-graduate Pass & Honours Courses from the academic year 2012-13 and to say further that the admission in enhanced seats must be done on the basis of subject-wise merit lists observing existing reservation policy. Subject-wise merit lists along with marks shall be uploaded in the Website and displayed in the Notice Board of the concerned Colleges for the purpose of maintaining transparency in the entire admission process.

This may be treated as urgent.
