A question has been raised in connection with the online admission being implemented from the academic year 2015-16 in the State aided Universities and Colleges whether the Students' Unions / Councils/ other bodies claiming to represent students can set up **HELP DESK** on the campus for guiding / counseling / assisting the applicants.

After a careful consideration of all aspects of the matter, including the need for an orderly and tranquil environment on the campuses, it is hereby clarified that <u>no</u> HELP DESK shall be allowed to be setup by anybody / Association / Union / Council, on the campus of State aided Universities and Colleges during the online admission process.
