Referring to the subject cited above, the undersigned is directed to state that part-time teachers and contractual whole-time teachers on non -government colleges, in West Bengal, who retired on superannuation after attaining the age of 60 years and after rendering at least 10 years of continuous and satisfactory service, are entitled to get gratuity amounting to R. 1.00 lakh (Rupees one lakh) only each as per Order No. 751-Edn(CS), dt. 21.09.2010.

Hence, the undersigned is directed to approve the payment of gratuity of R. 1.00 lakh(Rupees one lakh) only to the abovementioned pay time teachers and contractual whole-time teachers payable under the Head "007-Payment of Gratuity to Part Time Teacher(PTT) and Contractual Whole Time Teacher(CWTT) of State Aided **Non**-Government Colleges" with detailed head "04-Pension/Gratuities" Sub-ordinate to "2071-Pension & Other Retirement Benefits-01-Civil-104-Gratuities-NP-Non-Plan" under Demand No 18 vide Finance Department's Memo No. 552-F.B., dt. 11.08.2014.

The undersigned is further directed to say that the Principal/ Teacher-in-Charge of the College will draw the gratuity amount of R. 1.00 lakh(Rupees one lakh) only from the concerned Treasury or Pay & Account Office and disburse the same to the incumbents.
