Tender Notice

Notice number- DAC/NIT-16/BOT/2016-17, dated 05-10-2016

According to the meeting held on 05th October, 2016, sealed quotations are invited for educational excursion of the department of Botany at Gangtok, Pelling and adjoining areas of the Eastern Himalaya including Gangtok Botanic Garden, Nathu La Pass, Baba Mandir, Tsomgo Lake (Changu Lake), Rumtek Monastery from Gangtok and Rabangla, Khanchendzongna waterfall, Khecheopari Lake, Sewaro rock Garden, Rimbi River Bank, Darap Cherry Village, Pemayangtse Monastery, Singshore Bridge, Tashiding Monastery, Dubdi Monastery, Phamrong Water Falls etc. from Pelling. We will start our excursion tentatively on February, 2017 on the basis of the availability of the railway sleeper class tickets. The total duration of the educational excursion will be 7-8 days including 6 nights stay in a secured and comfortable hotel nearer to the M.G. Marg Point, Gangtok and in the heart of the Pelling City having well, cozy and clean rooms on the basis of a 3 members sharing at per double bedded room (for 27 ± 2 students), two members sharing at per double bedded room (for two male teachers) and one member sharing at per single bedded room (for one departmental staff). Good quality of food should be maintained. During this excursion we will need two times heavy non-veg food (during Lunch and Dinner) and two times light food (during breakfast and evening snacks) including two times tea for all the members. After completion of the excursion we will return back to our place after the above mentioned days.

Educational excursion itinerary:

- **Day 1:** Boarding from SDAH/HWH/KOAA railway station by train to NJP, overnight at train.
- **Day 2:** Reach NJP railway station in the morning. Good quality breakfast will be served to the students, teachers and staff.

After taking breakfast proceed to Gangtok by preferably Tata Sumo or any 10-sitter vehicle sharing 10 members per vehicle. On the way, we will see the different Bryophytes, Pteridophytes and Gymnosperms of the different region.

Reach a good quality hotel nearer to the M.G. Marg, Gangtok which has well, cozy, cleaned and secured rooms for all the members.

- Room sharing strictly on the basis of
 - 03 members per double bedded room for 27 ± 2 students
 - 02 members per double bedded room for two male teachers
 - 01 member per single bedded room for one departmental staff

A good quality non-vegetable lunch will be provided. After taking lunch we will visit to the M.G. Marg for specimen collection.

At evening we will return back to the hotel. Evening snacks will be served along with tea.

At night good quality non-vegetable food will be provided. Overnight stay in the hotel.

- **Day 3:** After taking our breakfast, in the morning, we will visit to the Nathu La Pass, Baba Mandir, Changu Lake by preferably Tata sumo sharing 10 members per vehicle to study the different types of vegetation of different places. After observation, we will return back to the hotel and take our Lunch. Then taking the lunch, we will again move for the collection of the different flora from the surrounding areas of our Hotel. After collection of the different flora we will again back to the hotel and take the evening snacks along with tea.

Identification and description of the different flora will be given to the students by the departmental teachers in the evening.

A good quality dinner (non-veg) will be served at night. Overnight stay in the hotel.

- **Day 4:** Bed tea and breakfast will be provided in the morning. At about 10 A.M. we will move for the Gangtok Botanic Garden and other adjoining areas (Local site seeing) preferably Tata sumo sharing 10 members per vehicle to exploring the knowledge of the subject and for the quadrat study.

At afternoon we will come back to the hotel and take our lunch (non-veg) and take rest.

At evening we will take our snacks and tea. During this time the teachers will help the students to calculate the different parameters of the quadrature study.

A good quality dinner (non-veg) will be served at night. Overnight stay in the hotel.

Day 5: Bed tea and heavy breakfast will be provided in the room. At 10 A.M. we will proceed for the Pelling.

Reach a good quality hotel nearer to the heart of the city of Pelling which has well, cozy, cleaned and secured rooms for all the members.

- Room sharing strictly on the basis of
 - 03 members per double bedded room for 27 ± 2 students
 - 02 members per double bedded room for two male teachers
 - 01 member per single bedded room for one departmental staff

A good quality non-vegetable lunch will be provided. After taking lunch we will visit for specimen collection.

At evening we will return back to the hotel. Evening snacks will be served along with tea.

At night good quality non-vegetable food will be provided. Overnight stay in the hotel.

- **Day 6:** After taking our breakfast, in the morning, we will visit to the Rabangla and its adjoining areas by preferably Tata sumo sharing 10 members per vehicle to study the different types of vegetation of different places. After observation, we will return back to the hotel and take our Lunch.

In the evening, the excursion team will take the evening snacks along with tea. During this time, departmental teachers will help the students to press the plant specimens for the making of herbarium specimen. Identification and description of the different flora will also be given to the students by the departmental teachers in the evening.

A good quality dinner (non-veg) will be served at night. Overnight stay in the hotel.

- **Day 7:** Bed tea and breakfast will be provided in the morning. At about 10 A.M. we will move for the Local site seeing including Khanchendzongna waterfall, Khecheopari Lake, Sewaro rock Garden, Rimbi River Bank, Darap Cherry Village, Pemayangtse Monastery, Singshore Bridge, Tashiding Monastery, Dubdi Monastery, Phamrong Water Falls etc. and other adjoining areas to exploring the knowledge of the subject. If this journey will take a very long time, then the lunch (non-veg) will be served on the way.

At afternoon we will come back to the hotel and take our lunch (non-veg) and take rest.

At evening we will take our snacks and tea. During this time identification and description of the different flora will be given to the students by the departmental teachers in the evening. In the evening the travel agent will also arrange a camp fire programme (about 2-3 hours) for the students.

A good quality dinner (non-veg) will be served at night. Overnight stay in the hotel.

- **Day 8:** Bed tea and heavy breakfast will be provided in the room. At 10 A.M. we will proceed for the NJP station to get our return train.

After reaching the NJP station we will take the lunch (non-veg). Evening snacks and tea will be provided at the NJP railway station.

Boarding from NJP by train to SDAH/HWH. Dinner will be provided at the train.

N.B.

- i. Safety and security of all the students should be maintained.**
- ii. Hygienic food should be maintained.**
- iii. Fish/mutton/chicken alternately should be provided in lunch and dinner.**
- iv. Well, cozy, cleaned and secured rooms should be provided on the above said sharing basis. Separate room will be provided for girls and boys students.**
- v. As per norms stated by eastern railway students, teachers and staff will get railway concession for the said journey.**
- vi. Arrange a local guide with good knowledge of the local flora/vegetation for the whole excursion.**
- vii. Experienced travel agent who has the experience of at least 7 long excursions will be highly entertained.**
- viii. Rate parameter is not only the parameter of the selection of the travel agent but also experience is another important parameter for the selection of the travel agent.**
